EXPANSION OF ALCOHOL SALES



- ✓ **VOTE YES** for consumer convenience by progressively increasing the number of allowed beer and wine licenses from nine (9) to eighteen (18), minus any full liquor licenses owned. The number of full liquor licenses will be set at seven (7), which would be the most allowed in a Three-Tier State.
- ✓ **VOTE YES** to improve public safety by prohibiting self-checkout of alcohol beverages and making a fine for selling to a minor applicable to gross sales and not just for alcohol beverages.
- ✓ **VOTE YES** to promote state tourism by allowing for VALID out of state IDs to be relied upon by a retailer. Massachusetts is the only state in the United States that does not permit an alcohol beverage retailer to reasonably rely on valid out-of-state IDs.
